This course is for certified law enforcement officers only and medics assigned to teams. We train in all weather conditions except for lightning or other extremely hazardous conditions. This class consists of long days, plan accordingly!

**Meeting Location:** 100 Gamecock Drive, Anniston, AL 36205

**Program Description:** This approved seventy-two-hour Basic SWAT Course will certify each student. The program will begin at 7:45 am. The days are long, extending 14+ hours each day. This program is designed to address and reinforce basic tactical concepts, movement, entry and clearing using repetitive scenario based force on force scenarios. Training includes tactics, techniques and procedures for law enforcement tactical operations, use force case law, medical training, rapid decision making during scenarios and many other concepts. Course includes a Tac Med Solutions Operator IFAK valued at more than \$80.00 each - for every student (coyote tan). We do not haze students. All students are treated as professionals.

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This course requires moderate to high levels of physical fitness and the class learning objectives will fatigue the student. The student must be able to walk, run short distances, kneel, squat, bend, assume prone positions and recover to any position unassisted. Students should not attend that have bad backs, heart conditions or any other physical limitations.

**Instructors:** Instructors assigned to coordinate and work with these programs have significant backgrounds in law enforcement/military and special weapons training as well as tactical training. The instructional staff includes personnel from federal law enforcement, military, former state department contractors.

All instructors are assigned to active law enforcement tactical teams WITHIN THE STATE OF ALABAMA. We feel this is critical for the success of the program. This also allows the instructors to discuss Use of Force Case law as it pertains to **LE tactical operations**.

**Standards:** Complete all training objectives. APOSTC Pistol Qualification: Minimum 80 Percent; Pass a 4 minute live fire performance examination, pass an exposure to OC (gas) environment without a gas mask, function as a member of a team and attend all training sessions.

**Lodging:** Tuition does not include lodging. Students must make their own arrangements.

**Firearms:** **The student should be able to load, unload, manipulate, handle and reload their firearm in a SAFE and CONTROLLED manner.** The student should be familiar with their weapon systems and equipment and possess the basic knowledge to be able to disassemble their firearm for cleaning, maintenance, and problem solving. The student will learn the four weapon safety rules and abide by the rules at all times. We cannot afford an unsafe student in any class. Safety violations are dealt with swiftly.

## Each student needs to bring:

- Wrap around eye protection
- Hearing protection (bring multiple sets of foam hearing protection)
- Body armor/tactical vest
- Flashlight: weapon mounted and/or handheld with lots of spare batteries
- Duty pistol, 3 magazines and holster – Ammunition: 400 Rounds
- A zero'ed rifle or submachine gun, 3 magazines, Ammunition: 400 Rounds
- Groin protection (Small towel or athletic cup) to protect your groin area
- Long sleeve T-shirts or light weight jackets (No red clothing – Instructors wear red)
- Ballistic helmet (if issued) and gas Mask
- Gloves to protect hands from non-lethal training ammunition
- Throat protection (Towel) and groin protection (small towel)
- (1) Noise Flash Diversion Device (NFDD)
- Coolers with food, ice and drinks (we allow these items in the training area)

### **Training Weapons, Safety Gear and Ammunition:**

- Non-lethal training weapon (Glock Simunition© or similar)
- 200 Simunition© FX Marking Cartridges ® or Non-lethal training ammunition that fits Glock Simunition© FX Marking weapon
- NLTA Safety Helmet
- If you cannot provide rounds, Safety Helmet, NFDD or weapon, please contact me personally (256.525.9808)

NOTE: This course uses non-lethal training ammunition during force on force training. Students must bring items that cover all exposed skin during training. Bring something to cover your neck, arms, hands and pad the groin area.

**Credit cards** are accepted over the phone: Contact 256-525.9808 and advise which course you are attending, date of the class and the amount to be charged. NOTE: A 2.5 percent fee will be added to all credit card payments.

Failure to provide payment prior to the course will result in a non-registered status and you will be told to leave.
