Course Title: Counter Assault Training (CAT) **Date:** April 16-18, 2018
Length: 3 Days **CEU's:** 30 CEU's **Type:** Advanced

This course is for certified law enforcement officers only. We train in all weather conditions except for lightning or other extremely hazardous conditions. This class is a long day, plan accordingly!

Meeting Location: Northeast Alabama Police Academy, 100 Gamecock Drive, Anniston, AL 36205 - exact classroom number is subject to change. No live weapons are to be brought into the classroom

Program Description: This three day - 30 hour course focuses on law enforcement TTP's using a 1 to 6 man combined elements. The course requires the successful completion of multiple live fire weapons qualifications. This course includes force on force training, active threat tactics, medical training and precision shooting. Participants should have attended a Basic SWAT Course AND previous active threat training. The course is oriented towards law enforcement officers who learn to rapid deployment contact team concept to stop violence.

ALL live fire qualifications are difficult and are competed daily. Students **MUST** qualify on handgun, shotguns and rifles. During qualifications, if a student fails that course of fire, the student will be given two chances to reshoot – total of three opportunities. If students fail the reshoot opportunities – students are then dropped from the program without refund. Students will qualify at the 100 meter mark and closer. Students will familiarize with targets out to 200 meters.

This course requires moderate to high levels of physical fitness and the class learning objectives will fatigue the student. The student must be able to walk, run short distances, kneel, squat, bend, assume prone positions and recover to any position unassisted. Students should not attend that have bad backs, heart conditions or any other physical limitations.

Instructors: Instructors assigned to coordinate and work with these programs have significant backgrounds in law enforcement/military and special weapons training as well as tactical training. The instructional staff includes personnel from federal law enforcement, military, former state department contractors.

Standards: Complete all training objectives. Complete all qualifications. Minimum 80 Percent on all qualifications, pass a live fire performance exams, function as a member of a team and attend all training sessions.

Firearms: **The student should be able to load, unload, manipulate, handle and reload their firearm in a SAFE and CONTROLLED manner.** The student should be familiar with their weapon systems and equipment and possess the basic knowledge to be able to disassemble their firearm for cleaning, maintenance, and problem solving. The student will learn the four weapon safety rules and abide by the rules at all times. We cannot afford an unsafe student in any class. Safety violations are dealt with swiftly.

Each student needs to bring:

- Wrap around eye protection/ear protection (bring lots of foam hearing protection)
- Body armor/tactical vest
- Flashlight (weapon mounted and/or handheld) with lots of spare batteries
- Shotgun
 - 50 slugs, 100 OO Buck, 25 bird shot
- Pistol, 3 magazines and holster – Ammunition: 500 Rounds
- A zero'ed rifle or submachine gun, 3 magazines, Ammunition: 400 Rounds
- Groin protection (Small towel or athletic cup) to protect your groin area
- Long sleeve T-shirts or light weight jackets (No red clothing – Instructors wear red)
- Ballistic helmet (if issued)
- Gas masks (if issued)
- 200 Simunition© FX Marking Cartridges ® or Non-lethal training ammunition that fits Glock Simunition© FX Marking weapons
 - Non-lethal training weapon
 - NLTA Safety Helmet
 - Throat protection (Towel)
 - Groin protection (small towel)
- **Students that do not bring a weapon and helmet will be charged \$15.00 rental fee for the week (15.00 FEE DOES NOT INCLUDE SIM Rounds)**
- Coolers with food, ice and drinks (we allow these items in the training area)

NOTE: This course uses non-lethal training ammunition during force on force training. Students must bring items that cover all exposed skin during training. Bring something to cover your neck, arms, hand's and pad the groin area.

Credit cards are accepted over the phone: Contact 256-525.9808 and advise which course you are attending, date of the class and the amount to be charged. NOTE: A 2.5 percent fee will be added to all credit card payments.

Failure to provide payment prior to the course will result in a non-registered status and you will be told to leave.
