Course Title: Advanced SWAT **Dates:** Nov 6-10, 2017

Program Description:

Day 1: Review basic tactical concepts, movement, clearing techniques, planning, vehicle assaults, gas, flash-bangs, hostage rescue and breaching. There are no classroom events on day one except registration procedures.

Day 2: Land navigation classroom and a required compass course (day and night) exercise, woodland operations, rural movements to objective.

Day 3: Multi-level entry, multiple entry points, live gas clearing, use of visual aids during clearing operations.

Day 4: All day live fire training. Students must pass a shoot-house qualification, handgun qualification and rifle qualification. Live fire day will test the student's limits.

Day 5: Graded exercises. The final day of training will consist of a graded operation. The operation will not be disclosed until the day of the exercise. All students must receive a "passing" status to graduate the course on the scenarios. These scenarios use non-lethal training ammunition (force on force). The program requires a minimum of 10 students.

This course requires moderate to high levels of fitness and the class learning objective will fatigue the student. The student must be able to walk, run short distances, kneel, squat, bend, assume prone positions and recover to any position unassisted. Students should not attend that have bad backs, heart conditions or any other physical limitations.

Instructors: Instructors assigned to coordinate and work with these programs have a significant background in law enforcement/military and special weapons training. The instructional staff includes personnel from federal law enforcement, military, former state department and municipal law enforcement agencies. All instructors assigned to teach in these programs attend special instructor training programs in the disciplines assigned.

Standards: Complete all training objectives. Rifle Qualification - Minimum 80 Percent; Pass a 3:30 minute live fire performance examination, multiple live fire exercises, land navigation course, graded missions, function as a member of a team and attend all training sessions.

Location: Meeting Location is at Northeast Alabama Police Academy, 100 Gamecock Drive, Anniston, AL 36205 in the Advanced Training Room (room is subject to change).

Registration: Email ARM_Group_LLC@yahoo.com directly with a prepared roster or register on the website www.arm-group-llc.com to confirm a seat. You will be notified once your seat is confirmed via email, text or phone call personally.

Each student needs to bring:

- Wrap around eye protection/ear protection (bring lots of foam hearing protection)
- Body armor/tactical vest
- Flashlight (weapon mounted and/or handheld) with lots of spare batteries
- Serviceable duty pistol with 3 magazines and duty or tactical holster
- Ammunition for duty pistol: 250 Rounds
- Serviceable rifle or subgun 2 magazines and sling
- Ammunition for duty rifle or subgun: 500 Rounds
- Lots of water: be prepared to hydrate
- Pen, pad and pencil
- Groin protection (Small towel or athletic cup)
- Long sleeve t-shirt or light weight jacket
- BDU type or other appropriate uniform
- Other tactical gear as appropriate
- Gas mask
- Compass (Silva, lensatic or other quality item)
- Protractor 1:24000
- Students are encouraged to bring non-lethal training ammunition and weapons (Please contact the academy first)
- Tourniquets (CAT or SOFT-W)

NOTE: This course uses non-lethal training ammunition during force on force training. Students must bring items that cover all exposed skin during training. Bring something to cover your neck, arms, hand's and pad the groin area.

SPECIAL NOTE: Students that do not demonstrate proper weapon handling skills, tactics and/or safety may be removed from the training. Live fire exercises are inherently dangerous. Safety violations will be dealt with harshly. We cannot afford to have unsafe personnel in the class. Students who do not perform to program standards may receive a Certificate of Attendance instead of completion.
