Course Title: Basic SWAT **Date:** Mar 6-10 and Oct 9-13, 2017

This course is for certified law enforcement officers only and medics assigned to teams. We train in all weather conditions except for lightning or other extremely hazardous conditions. This class is a long day, plan accordingly!

Program Description:

This APOSTC/ALEA approved sixty-hour Basic SWAT Course will certify each student. The program will begin at 8:00 a.m. on day one and will consist of five days of training. The days are long, extending 14+ hours each day. This program is designed to address and reinforce basic tactical concepts, movement, entry and clearing using repetitive scenario based force on force scenarios. Training includes tactics, techniques and procedures for tactical operations, use of force case law, medical training, rapid decision making during scenarios and many other concepts. Course costs includes a Tac Med Solutions Operator IFAK valued at more than \$80.00 each - for every student (coyote tan). We do not haze students. All students are treated as professionals.

This course requires moderate to high levels of physical fitness and the class learning objectives will fatigue the student. The student must be able to walk, run short distances, kneel, squat, bend, assume prone positions and recover to any position unassisted. Students should not attend that have bad backs, heart conditions or any other physical limitations.

Instructors: Instructors assigned to coordinate and work with these programs have significant backgrounds in law enforcement/military and special weapons training as well as tactical training. The instructional staff includes personnel from federal law enforcement, military, former state department contractors now in law enforcement and municipal law enforcement agencies. All instructors assigned to teach in these programs attend special instructor training programs in the disciplines assigned.

We use instructors that represent 15 different STATE OF ALABAMA agencies. All instructors are assigned to active law enforcement tactical teams WITHIN THE STATE OF ALABAMA. We feel this is critical for the success of the program. This also allows the instructors to discuss Use of Force Case law as it pertains to **LE tactical operations**. All scenarios used in the training are based on their real world situations (good and bad) which keeps the training current and up to date.

Standards: Complete all training objectives. APOSTC Pistol Qualification: Minimum 80 Percent; Pass a 4 minute live fire performance examination, pass an exposure to OC (gas) environment without a gas mask, function as a member of a team and attend all training sessions.

Firearms

The student should be able to load, unload, manipulate, handle and reload their firearm in a SAFE and CONTROLLED manner. The student should be familiar with their weapon systems and equipment and possess the basic knowledge to be able to disassemble their firearm for cleaning, maintenance, and problem solving. The student will learn the four weapon safety rules and abide by the rules at all times. We cannot afford an unsafe student in any class. Safety violations are dealt with swiftly.

Each student needs to bring:

- Wrap around eye protection/ear protection (bring lots of foam hearing protection)
- Body armor/tactical vest
- Flashlight (weapon mounted and/or handheld) with lots of spare batteries
- Serviceable duty pistol with three magazines and holster (duty or tactical)
- Ammunition for duty pistol: 300 Rounds
- Serviceable duty rifle or submachine gun with three magazines
- Ammunition for duty rifle: 200 Rounds
- Lots of water: be prepared to hydrate
- Pen, pad and pencil
- Groin protection (Small towel or athletic cup) to protect your groin area
- Long sleeve T-shirts or light weight jackets (No red clothing – Instructors wear red)
- BDU Type or other appropriate uniform
- Other tactical gear as appropriate
- Ballistic helmet (if issued)
- Gas masks (if issued)
- Gloves and elbow/knee pads (if issued)
- Non-lethal training weapons and ammunition (Simunition® FX only) if available
 - We provide all NLTA weapons, ammunition and safety helmet
- If you have Simunition® FX helmets and training gear please bring it
- One Noise Flash Diversion Device (NFDD) if available – which means if you can bring it please bring one

- Coolers with food, ice and drinks (we allow these items in the training area)
- No weapons or ammunition are to be brought into the classroom

NOTE: This course uses non-lethal training ammunition during force on force training. Students must bring items that cover all exposed skin during training. Bring something to cover your neck, arms, hand's and pad the groin area.

Payment: Checks, Money Orders and Purchase Orders (may be faxed to 256-238-0171) and must be made out to ARM Group LLC. Payment MUST presented by the end of the first day of class. If the agency must have an invoice, we can prepare an invoice for your agency.

Failure to provide payment prior to the course will result in a non-registered status and you will be told to leave.
